

1. Trick or Treat candy is not for pets. Chocolate is especially dangerous for dogs.
2. Halloween costumes and visitors can be stressfull for your pet. Keep your pets safe inside while Trick or Treaters roam.
3. Please have identification on your pets. Microchip your pet and use identification collars.

Thanksgiving is also a festive time but can be dangerous for your pets.

1. Thanksgiving foods such as turkey skin and pie are not good for your pets. Certain artificial sweeteners can be toxic for your pets.
2. Poultry bones can be fatal for your pets. PUT YOUR TRASH AWAY IMMEDIATELY, so your pets don't have access to bones and other unhealthy items.
3. Visitors can also be stressful for your pets. Put them away in a quiet area.
